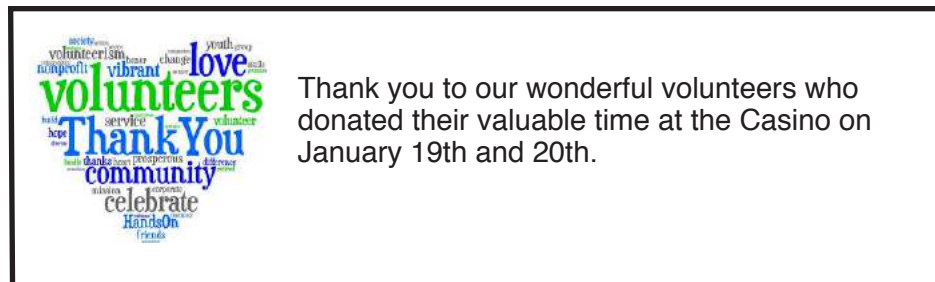

Soccer Registration

Come play soccer with Lendrum Community this season!

Outdoor soccer is affordable, fun, and a great way for your child to meet other children in your community. Outdoor Soccer begins the 1st week of May (weather permitting) and ends late June, except for teams proceeding to post season play (U13-U19) who may play into July & August.

Outdoor Soccer Registration starts February 1st and ends February 29th.
Registration is a two-step process:

1. Parents must go to the SWEMSA website (emsasouthwest.com) to enter player details and print off forms. You can pay online or at the in-person registration.
2. Come to one of the in-person registrations at the Lendrum Community Hall (11335-57 Avenue NW) taking place:

February 16th from 10 am to 12 pm

February 23rd from 10 am to 12 pm

Remember to bring the following items to the in-person registration:

- Printed registration forms
- Proof of age for player (e.g. health care card, birth certificate)
- Proof of residence for player and residence (e.g. guardian drivers license or utility bill)
- Deposit cheques (one \$50 uniform deposit per player, and one \$50 volunteer deposit per family), and
- Registration cheques (if not paying online).

You must be a Community League Member to play community soccer. Memberships may be purchased online (via www.lendrum.org) or at the Community Hall during soccer registration.

Our community soccer program is completely run by parent volunteers, so I invite all families to pitch in and help make the upcoming season amazing! There are countless ways to help, including coaching, coordinating referees, organizing equipment, and helping out at the season wrap-up party.

Volunteer Positions

Aging in Place Coordinator

The Lendrum Community League is hoping to be a welcoming place for the seniors in our neighbourhood. We are looking for a volunteer who will:

- Learn about and promote services available for seniors
- Coordinate a neighbourhood snow angels program
- Connect seniors to available resources
- Develop additional programming for seniors if there is demand
- Find out what skills and knowledge Lendrum seniors can share with the community
- Be a voice for neighbourhood seniors at the league

This is a new position for our league so it will evolve with the individual who fills the role.

Hall Maintenance Volunteer

The Lendrum Community League is looking for volunteers who can help with small maintenance tasks around the hall. The volunteer(s) would be contacted by the hall rental coordinator for odd jobs such as:

- Changing lightbulbs
- Minor plumbing work
- Small repairs
- Rodent control

If you are willing to help out in this role we would like to hear from you! It is not anticipated that this role will take a lot of time but it could range from zero to a few hours a month.

Abundant Community Edmonton Lendrum Coordinator

Around five years ago Lendrum became part of the Abundant Community Edmonton initiative. You may have had a block connector come to your house and interview you to find out about your skills, interests and abilities. The Lendrum Community League would like to take the information that has been gathered to date and use it to help guide programming and other decisions. We are looking for a volunteer who can act as the Abundant Community Edmonton Coordinator. This person would:

- Analyse the existing information to suggest new events or groups
- Reinvigorate the block connector program (there have been many new people move to the neighbourhood since 2014!). This could entail recruiting new block connectors.
- Work with the Abundant Community Edmonton program to identify ways that the initiative can generally improve our community.

This position would likely require a time commitment of 5 hours per month. This is an estimate and would likely depend on the individual's level of interest and the direction they take the initiative within the neighbourhood.

Lendrum Hall Rentals Coordinator

The Lendrum Community League is looking for a volunteer who can help us run rentals at the hall. The role is crucial for continued hall rentals (even to community members). The position would start in April with some overlap with the existing hall rental coordinator. The hall rental coordinator will:

- Monitor email and provide hall rental agreement to prospective renters.
- Arrange bookings and update calendar.
- Collect damage deposit and verify post event clean-up.
- Manage hall keys
- Liaise with custodian and maintenance volunteers.
