Civics

Autonomous Cars On Farm

The University is testing an autonomous cars on the university farm. The car is about the size of a golf car but can fit 15 people and it is electric powered. There will always be a driver present. Testing of the vehicle will last 2 hours at a time. Car and pedestrian traffic on specific farm roads will be prohibited at the time of the test. There will be signs to direct pedestrians. Google, Apple and Tesla are funding the research.

Crime Tasks Force

Parkallen started a crime task force in cooperation with Lendrum and other community leagues. The task force met with Edmonton Police Service in October. Edmonton's bus routes are changing. The City is hoping to improve service by providing increased frequency on main routes and having community feeders. LRT Warning Bells

Lendrum residents were concerned about the loudness of LRT warnings at the 60th street crossing. The City provided the following information about the signals:

All Edmonton LRT signals are set between 80dB and 95dB.

At the 60th street pedestrian crossing signals are set at 80dB and the vehicle bells are turned off. The City does test the loudness of signals periodically.

Alberta Health Services New Lab

An engineering consultant reviewed potential traffic flows and recommended a 500 lot parkade and some road modifications for the 1000 new employees. Traffic is not anticipated to change noticeably.

Capital Region Housing Project on 60th Street

The new Capital Region Housing building north of 60th Avenue is delayed. Demolition and construction will begin in summer 2019 and construction is anticipated to take two years. Current residents must leave by May 2019.


Community Energy Efficiency Projects



Despite the challenging weather this fall, Mme Lewis and friends were able to harvest a "bumper crop" of tomatoes and make fresh salsa for the school! Greetings from École Avalon School. It has been a busy summer and fall at the school. We have had our exterior windows replaced over the past year and we have included security grills to provide additional protection from vandalism. The school is currently having a lighting upgrade as we switch our lights over to the more reliable and efficient LED fixtures. This includes the exterior lighting so neighbours may notice the different lights around the school in the coming months. Over the summer we also had the replacement of the basketball tarmac at the back of the school. It is now a much safer surface for students and community members to enjoy.

Avalon has grown from last year and now has close to 500 students enrolled. This continues to be great news for the viability of the school. Of the almost 500 students, approximately 140 live in the school catchment area. That means that Avalon continues to be a school of choice. We currently have students attending from 32 different junior high areas in Edmonton. The many families that visit Avalon witness the beautiful park and lush sports fields that are maintained by Lendrum community volunteers. We thank you for allowing us to be a partner in the community.
