

Civics

At the beginning of March, the University of Alberta updated community leagues on the status of construction on the farm.

- Two soccer fileds will be constructed near the 63 avenue farm entrance this summer. The fileds will be ready for the 2020 soccer seasons. One will be sunken like Lendrum's soccer field.
- The roads adjacent to the Saville Centre will see construction this summer to improve pedestrian crossing safety. The University is addressing recent pedestrian-vehicle incidents.
- A two-story building about the size of a large house called "the cube" will be built over the next two years near the 60th avenue entrance to the farm. The cube will facilitate the future power needs of south campus.
- The "feed mill" which is a structure adjacent to the south west of the Saville Centre will be demolished in the next year and its functions transferrred to the Discovery Centre which is the large building at the end of 60th street.
- A double arena is planned to the west of the Saville Centre and has a city commitment for funding but needs additional funds to proceed.
- The Department of Kinesiology is exploring the possibility of a cross country ski trail on the farm close to the Saville Cengre where existing lighting can be used to advantage. The farm management does not want organizations like Ski2LRT using snowmobiles to build trails because recreational snowmobilers might decide to start using the farm based on the example.
- Demolition of some Mitchener Park residences will start soon as the buildings are vacated. The university will transfer the land to the University Land Trust. The Trust has not identified a final use for the land.
- The university is willing to come to the community hall to discuss the relationship between it and Lendrum if residents are interested. The university is doing a broad consultation with Albertans on the university's public role.

In other news, the construction of the super lab has started north of the school for the deaf. The UCP has said they will cancel the construction if elected.

The City is undertaking a revision of zoning bylaws to simplify the number of zones and associated rules.
